



# Haryana Monitoring and Evaluation Framework

Sustainable Development Goals







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### Introduction



During its 70th Session on 25th September 2015, the United Nations General Assembly adopted "Transforming Our World: The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development" comprising 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and 169 associated targets. The SDGs integrate the three dimensions of development - economic, social, and environmental - and provide a blueprint for achieving a sustainable future for all. The goals are universal, interconnected, and indivisible, and therefore require comprehensive and participatory approaches to ensure no one is left behind. The 5P's people, planet, prosperity, peace, and partnership - capture the broad scope of the agenda. Countries are primarily responsible for following up and reviewing the progress made in implementing the goals and targets at the national level till 2030.

The SDGs provide an international framework to move towards more equitable, peaceful, resilient, and prosperous societies by 2030 while living within sustainable planetary boundaries. Countries are expected to establish a national framework for achieving these goals, and implementation and success will depend on countries' own sustainable development policies, plans, and programmes. The 2030 Agenda emphasizes the need for quality, reliable, and disaggregated data to measure progress on the targets and ensure the central, transformative promise of "Leave No One Behind (LNOB)."

The Government of India is strongly committed to achieving the SDGs and has initiated a series of nation-wide welfare and developmental programs to integrate the

SDGs into the country's ongoing national and sub-national policies and programs. At the national level, NITI Aayog has mapped the SDGs with centrally sponsored programs of different central Ministries/Departments. The Government is committed to ensuring "Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas, Sabka Vishwas, Sabka Prayas" in the spirit of the Sustainable Development Goals' motto of "Leaving No One Behind."

Monitoring and evaluation are essential for assessing the extent to which policies and resource allocations for implementing the SDGs result in meaningful outcomes. Reliable data is crucial for better monitoring of the SDGs and data-driven decision-making policies. Given the complex and interconnected nature of the SDGs, the Government of India has developed a sound monitoring and evaluation framework. The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) has developed the National Indicator Framework (NIF) comprising 306 indicators (initially, now 286 indicators) following due consultation with concerned Ministries/Departments, UN Agencies, and other stakeholders. The NIF is the backbone of monitoring the SDGs at the national level and provides appropriate direction to policymakers and implementing agencies of various schemes and programmes.

At the sub-national level, the States/UTs have the primary responsibility for follow-up and review at the state, district, and local government levels regarding the progress made in implementing the SDG goals and targets and their achievements. Therefore, it is important for States to develop their own State Indicator Framework (SIF) and District Indicator

Framework (DIF) based on their individual critical development priorities, data requirements, available infrastructure, and resources.

### Initiatives for Developing Haryana SDG Indicator Framework

The Government of Haryana is fully committed to achieving the SDGs in the state and has taken several concrete steps towards this end. It was the first state to develop its own SDG Vision 2030 report, which outlines its goals and targets for 2030. To monitor progress and ensure effective implementation, the government established the Sustainable Development Goals Coordination Centre (SDGCC) in collaboration with UNDP India, housed at the Swarna Jayanti Haryana Institute for Fiscal Management (SJHIFM) under the Department of Finance.

One of the initial tasks of the SDGCC was to develop a State Indicator Framework (SIF) for Haryana, for which relevant departments were identified and two nodal officers were designated by each department to provide necessary information. Subsequently, several consultative and capacity-building meetings were organized at both SJHIFM and departmental levels to facilitate a better understanding of data availability, key indicators, periodicity, and budget alignments. The development of the SIF is a crucial step towards monitoring the progress of SDGs in Haryana and ensuring their effective implementation.

### State Indicator Framework (SIF) for SDGs

The State Indicator Framework (SIF) has been developed to align with the National Indicator Framework, which includes 558 indicators and 110 SDG targets. After consulting with concerned departments, only 194 indicators from the National Indicator Framework were included in the SIF. This framework serves as a tool to help the state develop implementation strategies and allocate resources effectively, as well as act as a report card to measure progress towards sustainable development and ensure the accountability of all

stakeholders for achieving the SDGs.

Some key features of the State Indicator Framework include:

- The SIF includes 558 indicators covering all 17 SDGs, except SDG Goal 14.
- Out of the 558 indicators, 194 are from the National Indicator Framework.
- An additional 35 new indicators have been included in alignment with NITI Aayog's SDG India Index indicators list.
- The indicators have been mapped with relevant departments of the Government of Haryana and their respective data sources.
- Baseline year and data, along with targets, have also been mapped to the indicators.

### District Indicator Framework (DIF) for SDGs

The District Indicator Framework (DIF) of Haryana is aligned with the National Indicator Framework and State Indicator Framework, comprising of 350 indicators and 83 SDG targets. Only 88 indicators from the National Indicator Framework were selected based on consultations with concerned departments. The DIF serves as a monitoring tool at the district level for implementing SDGs, providing a basis for developing implementation strategies and allocating resources. It also acts as a report card for measuring progress towards sustainable development and ensuring accountability of stakeholders.

Key features of the District Indicator Framework are:

- It includes 350 indicators for all 17 SDGs, except SDG Goal 14.
- 88 indicators are from the National Indicator Framework, and an additional 16 indicators are aligned with NITI Aayog's SDG India Index indicators list.
- The indicators are mapped with relevant departments of the Government of Haryana and their data sources.
- Baseline data and targets are also mapped with the indicators.

#### **About the Document**

The monitoring and evaluation (M&E) framework for SDGs in Haryana is a dynamic process that will evolve and mature over time, taking into account data and capacity limitations. The main responsibility for data collection lies with the departments of the Government of Haryana. Data for the last 5 years have been provided against the indicators, and the primary task now is to obtain the data for the state-specific indicators belonging to different departments of the state of Haryana. Currently, 37 indicators are still under compilation at the concerned department level and are highlighted in red.

The state-specific added new indicators are denoted by a capital letter 'S,' while those indicators taken directly from the National Indicator Framework (NIF) have no prefix. The development of SDG indicators is an ongoing process, and the SDGCC-SJHIFM, in consultation with concerned departments, is working on measuring the progress of state schemes/programs by including key indicators in this framework. The relevance of indicators to SDG targets has been the main criteria in developing the indicators in the State and District Indicator Framework. Several indicators were found relevant to more than one target and have been repeated accordingly.

### Haryana SDG Indicators – Data Visualization

The development of the Haryana SDG Dashboard is currently underway and it will serve as a centralized repository for SDG indicators with disaggregated data. The dashboard will offer time series data for SDG indicators, organized by Goals and Targets, and will be presented using graphs, bar charts, and maps. The dashboard will provide

disaggregated data at the district level. The information on the dashboard will be regularly updated with the latest data obtained from various surveys or reported by the relevant departments.

#### Way Forward

Monitoring and evaluation play a crucial role in tracking the progress of the SDGs at global, regional, national, and local levels. To achieve this, the development of an indicator framework is the first step. With this in mind, the SDGCC-SJHIFM has developed a Monitoring and Evaluation Framework that will serve as a driver for the 2030 Agenda. The following are the next steps to achieve the SDG targets committed by the Government of Haryana:

- Obtain the last 3-5 years of data on the indicators from the concerned departments.
- Finalize the Local Indicator Framework with baseline and progress data.
- Establish an SDG Dashboard that will enable an IT-based monitoring framework to measure the progress of SDG indicators at the state, district, and local levels. This will also facilitate critical intervention and mid-course corrections to achieve the targets.
- Develop and implement capacity building and training programs on SDGs.
- Prepare District, Block, and Gram Panchayat Integrated Action plans aligned with the SDGs.
- Prepare the Haryana SDG Roadmap for 2030 and strategies for the effective implementation of SDGs.
